Mark Schwiebert serves as a member of the Corn Board of the National Corn Growers Association (NCGA), a producer-directed trade association headquartered in St. Louis, with a second office in Washington, D.C.

Schwiebert is a partner in a farm operation that grows corn, popcorn, soybeans and soft red winter wheat in Hamler, Ohio. He also owns and operates a farm drainage contracting business specializing in the installation of drainage tile.

Schwiebert serves as NCGA Corn Board liaison for the Public Policy Action Team and is secretary of CornPAC, the association's political action committee. He has served as a member of NCGA's Public Policy Action Team and the Finance Committee and as a liaison to the Food and Ag Export Alliance. He also has been a member of the board of directors of the Ohio Corn Growers Association for the past six years and served as president for a year. He is also a member of the state's corn checkoff board.
